Jarrell Middle School

The town of Jarrell, Texas, located in central Texas, was founded in 1909 at the intersection of an old stagecoach road and the proposed right-of-way for the new Bartlett and Western Railway.

Today, Jarrell is a fast growing but close-knit community located on busy Interstate 35 and its citizens proudly boast one of the toprated school districts in the state.

In April 2012, the Jarrell Independent School District Board of Trustees initiated a comprehensive program to build a new middle school at the site of the current middle school campus. After holding collaborative planning meetings with the school staff and the entire community, a design solution was created. The design included expanded classroom and core spaces and provided natural light and views to the outside from every classroom. Thoughtfully included were a large and easily accessible library, performance stage and outdoor eating area.

Also incorporated into the design were three unique floor-to-ceiling wall-length themed graphics that were designed by O'Connell Robertsin Architects in collaboration with the middle school's teachers.
